Eric Carle (1929–2021) was one of the best known illustrators of our time. The creator of more than 70 picture books, he combined winsome stories and exuberant collages that appeal to young readers and adults alike.

In 2002, Eric Carle and his late wife, Barbara Carle, founded The Eric Carle Museum of Picture Book Art in Amherst, Massachusetts. Since then, the Museum has been a tireless champion for picture book art, amassing a world-class collection of original illustrations and organizing exhibitions that travel the globe. The education programs, which focus on the joys of art and books, have reached hundreds of thousands of children.

Pass valid for admission to exhibits at Gillette Castle (castle tours to start Memorial Day weekend), Dinosaur State Park (exhibit hall closed for renovation until at least Sept 2022) and Fort Trumbull. **Hours:** CT State Parks and Forests grounds are open daily from 8 am until sunset.

The museum is dedicated to the life and work of Gertrude Chandler Warner, best known as the author of The Boxcar Children books. The museum is housed in an authentic 1920s New Haven R.R. boxcar with a collection of original signed books, photos and artifacts from Gertrude's life and career as a teacher in Putnam, and a recreation of the living space created by the Aldens—the Boxcar Children themselves. Putnam is Gertrude's hometown, and the museum is located across the street from her childhood home.

Admission to the museum is always free, but donations are accepted and appreciated.

With 150 hands-on exhibits, a state-of-the-art 3D digital theater, four educational labs, plus daily programs and events, the Connecticut Science Center offers endless exploration for children, teens and adults. Every part of science will be at a visitor's fingertips, from physics to forensics, geology to astronomy.
