Executive Summary:

A Request for Bid (RFB) for the construction of the Indian Trail School Access Road was developed and publicly bid. On February 26, 2020, the bid specification was released and published on the Daily Herald News. A pre-bid meeting and walk-thru were held on March 3, 2020. The Indian Trail School Access Road will commence construction before the end of the school year.

On April 2, 2020, four (4) bid packets were received, opened and read aloud. Bids were received by A Lamp Concrete, Tully Brothers Paving, D.K. Contractors, and Chicagoland Paving Contractors. After a careful review and analysis, Chicagoland Paving Contractors was the lowest responsible and responsive bidder, see attached bid tabulation.

Based on this information, the administration recommends at the April 21, 2020 Board meeting, that the Board approves awarding the construction of the Indian Trail School Access Road to Chicagoland Paving Contractors in the amount of approximately \$225,000.

Recommendation:

Roll call vote to approve and award the contract to Chicagoland Paving Contractors for the construction of the Indian Trail School Access Road in the amount of approximately \$225,000, as presented.
