

Wellesley Class of 1967 Meeting at 50th Reunion
Tower Court
Saturday, June 3, 2017

The meeting was called to order by class president Elaine Woo at 8:45AM. Elaine reported that more than 210 members of the Class of 1967 are registered for the 50th Reunion.

Minutes of the 2012 Class of 1967 meeting were read by class secretary Helen Currie Foster. A motion to approve the minutes was passed.

Class treasurer Leesa Heydenreich Campbell gave the treasurer's report. There is \$56,280 in our account. A motion to approve the report was accepted.

Janet Hoffman presented the slate of nominees for class officers for the next 5 years:

The slate was accepted by acclamation.

Elaine expressed thanks to the 3 Record Book chairs: Erica Johnson, Helen Sandalls, and Dana Stambaugh Semeraro. 79% of classmates contributed to the Record Book.

Elaine expressed thanks to the reunion chairs Ann Hayden Hamilton and Ann Brua Welch.

Beth Bates Johnson, incoming class president, thanked the officers for the last 5 years. In honor the outgoing class president the Class of 1967 and of the 2 reunion chairs, the Class of 1967 is giving \$1,000 to Wellesley Centers for Women and \$1,000 to Wellesley Student Aid.

Kathy Stone Kaufmann announced major gifts from our classmates to the internship program at the Wellesley Centers for Women. Figures for WCW were \$2,082,000 including a \$2 million bequest from Elizabeth ("Beth") Bates Johnson and her husband to create two new internships: the Elizabeth Bates Johnson '67 internship and the Janet Zollinger Giele Internship. This is part of a \$5 million bequest to Wellesley from Beth and her husband. The internship program will be known as the Class of 1967 internships at Wellesley Centers for Women.

Lolly MacMurray-Cooper reported on giving and thanked the whole team involved in fund raising for the past 5 years. As of June 1st, the Class of 1967 participation rate was 77.7%. Durant donors: 78. Total cash raised: \$14,020,000 over the past 5 years.

The meeting was adjourned at 9:15AM by Elaine.
