Well, it's been awhile since our last newsletter--we stopped publishing them and moved to more communication via e-mail when COVID hit--but we are back. The purpose of the newsletter is to provide regular and on-going information about the events of Sacajawea with the intention of our parent community staying informed and involved.

Thank you all for your patience and flexibility as we have implemented the Blended Learning structure this school year. Our teachers have been working incredibly hard to provide a strong and robust learning experience for all of your students--both in-school and remotely. We've faced challenges--are still facing some--but are becoming more adept at utilizing Canvas and establishing the routine and expectations for your students.

Thank you as well for your support of your students during this time. We want to encourage you to continue to support them, but to also allow some independence with your students' learning. One of our mantras since last spring is "We got this!" Our students also have "got this," or, at least, have the ability to get this.

- Students have the training in class to manage Canvas and should be able to navigate it effectively.
- Resources and help for students are provided each day at school and are only an email away if needed
- Encourage your students to persist; often the answers they need are available in the LMS if they commit to finding the solutions (they do it really well with their phones and video games).
- Parents do not need to co-teach; again, the students have the information and the resources to access their learning and be fully engaged.

- A schedule for home learning can be very beneficial; contact your child's teacher for ideas if it would be helpful.
- Each day--Monday through Friday--is a day of learning.

Finally, we are in a situation unlike anything any of us have experienced. Our schools, like our families, have had to adjust but we can do this! Thank you for your partnership.

Ashley Henigman, who has served as a Behavior Specialist at Hyalite and completed an administrative internship at SMS several years ago, has agreed to serve as the Assistant Principal for the remainder of the year. Many of our students and families know Mrs. Henigman from Hyalite and our staff is very excited to welcome her back to Sac.

Grades

Although Canvas is the primary forum for instruction, learning, and communication with students and families, reports on student progress are best found through **PowerSchool** accounts. Canvas will indicate whether the assignments have been submitted; PowerSchool will provide more detailed standards-based reporting on your student's growth. Emergency Drills

Throughout the year, we will be conducting emergency drills to prepare students and staff in the event of actual events which may disrupt our school. We intend to announce the drills at the beginning of each day when they are conducted, but this <u>list</u> will also provide the anticipated dates we will practice the drills. Students are informed of the protocols by teachers prior to the drills and follow-up discussions also take place. Our intention is to guide our students in understanding the purpose of the drills, teach efficient protocols, and maintain the safety of our students.

It has changed to a mostly digital program. Traditional clip out Box Tops are being phased out but you can still send them to school (make sure it doesn't say scan) to be turned in to the library.

The new process is so much easier!

- 1. Get the free new and improved **Box Tops mobile app** on your phone
- 2. Buy your groceries and ask for the receipt
- 3. Get into your car and take pictures of your receipt (within 14 days) with the app.
- 4. It will find any qualifying products and give 10 cents for each one to the school.

The money adds up and is used to enhance the book selection at our library.

It's costs you nothing but 30 seconds of your time and you can help ALL the students at your child's school. Encourage your friends and relatives to do the same.
