Dress Code Reminder:

With the weather getting warmer, we want to make sure your students are coming to school appropriately dressed.

- Straps on all shirts need to be at least one inch wide (the width of two fingers)
- Shorts & skirts for students in grades K-2 will not have a length requirement. Please make sure they are appropriate for school and not too tight or short.
- Shorts & skirts for grades 3-5 must be at least the length of student’s fingertips when arms are down by their side.
- Shirts, tops, etc., need to be long enough so that when a student raises his/her hands over his/her head, no bare skin is showing.
- Shirts with large armholes must have a t-shirt underneath them.
