### **Drug Take Back**

Drop off your old prescription or over the counter medications at the Gallatin County Sherriff's office in Three Forks on April 26<sup>th</sup> from 10AM-2PM. Protect our kids, families and environment by properly disposing of your unwanted and expired medications. Medicines in the home are the leading cause of accidental poisoning and flushed or unwanted medications can end up polluting our waters. Rates of prescription medication abuse are alarmingly high-over half the teens abusing medications get them from family member or friend, including the home medicine cabinet and often without their knowledge.

There is always a Drug Take Back Box located in the lobby of the Gallatin Law and Justice Center and at the downtown Police Department on North Rouse. Unused, unwanted or expired medication can be deposited at either location. Thank you!!
