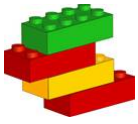

The last day of snack milk will be on Tuesday, June 9th. **No lunch will be served on the last day of school.** Any money that is left in your student's account will roll over into next year, whether your student comes back to Hyalite, transfers to another elementary school in our district, or is going on to middle school.
