

## American Recovery Program (ARP) Grant

The Beekmantown Central School District is submitting an application to the New York State Education Department for funding under the American Recovery Program (ARP). This application will encumber \$3,242,263 of the state's 90% ARP allocation that is earmarked for the District's COVID pandemic response and relief activities. Grant funds must be used between March 13, 2020 and September 30, 2024. The District's application plan includes:

- Professional Salaries and Benefits for grant-funded positions from August 31<sup>st</sup>, 2021 through September 30, 2024 including: 1.5 FTE Distance Learning Facilitators, 1.0 FTE STEM Career Pathways Teacher, and 1.0 FTE Student/Family Outreach Coordinator (Shared Associate Principal) and Summer Program Staff as required to provide remediation that will address COVID learning loss.
- Support Staff Salaries and Benefits for stipends and additional staff from August 31<sup>st</sup>, 2021 through September 2024 to support: Air quality control safety and building maintenance, School Nursing services, as required during summertime programing, Special Education support services for students to engage in summertime programing and Grants Procurement and Management Services.
- Supplies and Materials including: Air quality filters to service five district buildings over the next three years.
- Purchased Services Agreements with Institutions of Higher Education for students to enroll in CAP and AP courses.
