Gallatin Valley Farm to School is again hosting our Seed to Snack Garden Explorer Summer Camp for incoming 3rd-5th graders! The week-long summer camps will take place in late summer at the Hyalite Elementary or Irving Elementary School gardens and are focused on discovering where food comes from. Youth will learn how to grow and tend a garden and harvest fresh foods that they will use to cook delicious snacks every day. Students will create garden art, unleash their inner scientist as they observe and dissect flowers and insects, and become anthropologists as they examine our food system. We even take a field trip to a local farm!
