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<p><b>NEW STUDENT/KINDERGARTEN REGISTRATION FOR 2016-2017</b></p>
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**The 1<sup>st</sup> round of enrollment for new student and kindergarten registration for grades K-5 will be from Monday, March 7, through Monday, April 11.** Beginning March 7<sup>th</sup>, enrollment forms may be downloaded off the district website or enrollment packets may be picked up at the enrollment office at Willson School.

**All students NEW to the Bozeman School District, including all KINDERGARTEN students must complete and return a registration form along with current immunization records and birth certificate to the Enrollment Office at 404 West Main during the registration period.**

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Have your kids out grown their clothes? Do you have some smaller sized clothing you would like to pass on? We could use it here at Hyalite. We have a "borrow stash" of pants and shirts for students to use when they have an accident and it has dwindled down to nothing. We are in need of gently worn **elasticized waist pants such as sweat pants or leggings**. We can use both boys and girls pants in sizes 7-10. We are also low on both boys and girls underwear. 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### **Morning Drop Off/Pick up**

Morning drop off is in the East parking lot for all children. Please drive all the way to the far gate, drop your student, and loop around at the very end of the parking lot. **Do not park in the drop off lane with your car running.** If you want to walk your child to the playground, please go park your car in the parking lot. Students are not allowed to enter the front doors without an adult. **Please do not park in the staff parking lot on the West side of the building or the bus lane out in front of the building** when coming to school or when dropping off your children. An alternative to dropping off/picking up your child in the East lot would be to park on Yellowstone, Sheridan or Meagher Street and have your child walk to one of our crosswalk guards at Yellowstone and Sheridan. When picking up your child in the East parking lot, please be conscious of others who are doing the same. Do not park in a way that would block the flow of traffic or endanger students walking out to meet their parents. Also, consider turning right out of the parking lot, as we are trying to keep things flowing smoothly and safely at school. Thank you for helping us to keep your children safe!
