The 1<sup>st</sup> round of enrollment for new student and kindergarten registration for grades K-5 will be from Monday, March 7, through Monday, April 11. Beginning March 7<sup>th</sup>, enrollment forms may be downloaded off the district website or enrollment packets may be picked up at the enrollment office at Willson School.

All students **NEW** to the Bozeman School District, including all **KINDERGARTEN** students must complete and return a registration form along with current immunization records and birth certificate to the Enrollment Office at 404 West Main during the registration period.
