Student Equivalent Credits Policy - KRS 160.345 (2) (i) 8

**POLICY STATEMENT**

For students who have been in multiple school systems with multiple credit systems, the process of credit equivalency will be done by taking the academic record of each school year, dividing the number of credits earned at the school of that particular year by the number of credits possible to have been earned. Then take the fractional value times the number of credits possible at the new school. Doing this calculation for each year and then adding together the results needed by a student yields and "apple to apple" comparison in terms of credits needed by a student to be on schedule for graduation.

\*\* The DHS administration makes the final decision on all issues regarding the credits.
