**POLICY STATEMENT**

- A. All certified staff shall be assigned membership to at least one of the standing committees listed in the SBDM by-laws
- B. The Principal, in consultation with the SBDM council, will form the SBDM committees for the school year. Parents will be informed of committee membership opportunities and are encouraged to volunteer to serve on a committee.
- C. The Principal will present committees to the school council at the August SBDM meeting.
- D. Each standing committee will have no fewer than 4 members. Each committee will elect a chairperson and establish their regular meeting dates. The meeting date will be reported to the principal by the chair within 48 hours of the initial assembly. Each chairperson will serve a 1 year non-consecutive term.
- E. Each standing committee will establish its own frequency of meetings, date of meetings, and agenda. The principal will reserve the right to convene any committee meetings to assist with work that is appropriate for the respective committees.
- F. The school council may establish ad hoc committees to accept assignments at their discretion.
