Setting the Budget for School Instructional Funds Policy – KRS 160.345(2)(g)

POLICY STATEMENT

Each year after the principal receives the SBDM allocations from the Board Office, he/she shall draft a budget and convene a meeting with the SBDM Council to consider the instructional requests from each department. The principal will then prepare a recommendation for the distribution of the council's allocation for the school's instructional budget and the general fund budget based on the needs in the School Improvement Plan. The council will review the plan and budget to ensure that the needs in the CSIP have been addressed. The school council will approve the principal's recommendation by majority vote or consensus. The principal will provide reports to the council about the expenditure of funds and remaining balance as needed or requested.
