What is ArtWorks?

The Longfellow community believes that art is an integral component of every curricular aspect at our school enhancing the creative, emotional and intellectual growth of every child. Artworks is a year-round, parent funded arts program culminating in the ArtWorks Festival in May. The festival celebrates the Arts, showcases student talents via live and silent auctions, and is the primary fundraising event to support the art program at Longfellow. Other Artworks fundraisers and events include Original Works and the Children's Vision Art Show.

What is required from an artist?

The Artist agrees to provide quality art education focused on enhancing student's artistic, visual or performance experiences. The residency must emphasize artistic process and result in artistic growth & development for both students and teachers. A finished product for our silent and/or live auctions or KidsWork individual show during ArtWorks Festival should be incorporated for all visual arts residencies. All artists must complete a contract. If a project is likely to cost more than is available per allotted residency, it will need to be approved by the committee or a different, less-expensive project should be designed.
