

ROCK CEREMONY

At the end of each school year Grace Academy holds it's annual "Rock Ceremony." Those of you who have been at Grace in previous years know how meaningful this is in the life of the school and in the life of every participating family. For those of you who are new to Grace this year, here is a brief explanation:

We are told in Joshua, chapters 3 & 4, that as the Israelites crossed the Jordan going into the Promised Land, the Lord caused the waters to be cut off so His children crossed on dry land. He ordered that one stone for each tribe be taken from the dry riverbed, carried in to the Promised Land and built into an altar, so that when the Israelite children saw it, they would be moved to ask about the stones, giving the Israelites the opportunity to reflect on and speak about what the Lord had done for them.

In a similar way, we are building an "altar" to the LORD. Each year we ask our parents to select a stone and inscribe on it one character trait that they have seen the Lord grow in their child (ren) over the course of that year. Parents have an opportunity to speak a blessing over each child when they publicly present the rock and explain how the character trait was chosen. By the end of the child's time at Grace, he/she will have a visible reminder of God's work in his life. Just as the Israelites' stones were to serve as a memorial of the mighty works the LORD did in Israel, at Grace Academy, the rocks we use at our Rock ceremony are to serve as a lasting memorial of what the Lord has done in the lives of our children.

WHAT TO EXPECT?

First, the Grace Community will meet corporately for a brief word from the Head of School and prayer. After that, families will break into smaller groups across campus and gather in designated areas. Parents will have with them the rock(s) they've selected for their child(ren) with the character trait already inscribed. Families will take turns presenting the rocks to their children with a brief (one minute) description of why that trait was chosen for the specific child, including a scripture reference if desired. After the small group Rock Ceremony presentations families may gather for photos, fellowship, and celebrating outdoors at the picnic tables.

FAQ'S

1. Will Grace provide a rock at the ceremony, or do we bring one?

You need to pick a rock to present to your child ahead of time and bring it with the inscribed character trait the evening of Rock Ceremony.

2. How big should the rock be?

Please remember that you will be handing the rock over to your student. The size of an adult hand is a good general size. You can go smaller or larger- it is whatever your preference is. Please remember that these are rocks that will be around for many years, so keep storage in mind when picking a rock!

4. Do I decorate the rock?

That is your decision. Below is an example of some Rock Ceremony rocks.



4. What type of character traits are typical?

We're glad you asked. We've included a list of sample character traits below as well as corresponding scripture references. Please feel free however to use a trait not listed below. We encourage you to spend some time thinking about how the Lord has worked in your individual child over the school year.
