

TELEVISION BROADCASTING 1

This course is designed to provide students with the basic knowledge and skills related to the television broadcasting industry. This course includes instruction and hands-on assignments in the following areas: camera operation, audio systems, lighting systems, pre-production, studio operations, control room operations, visual effects and graphics, and copyright laws.

- Students will be able to understand and demonstrate knowledge of post-production.
- Students will be able to understand and demonstrate knowledge of broadcast production equipment and components.
- Students will be able to understand and demonstrate knowledge of control room and studio personnel.
- Students will be able to understand and practice copyright laws, ethics, and legal issues
