

# Non-Commissioned Security Officer Level II

## INDUSTRY-BASED CERTIFICATION DESCRIPTION

A student who completes the non-commissioned security officer level II certification could work in a variety of occupations, including security guard and personal security agent.

Some of the work associated with this certification and its usual occupations includes preventing physical access to restricted areas, investigating illegal or suspicious activities, and responding to minor emergencies. Observing and monitoring access or flow of people to stop possible problems and the prevention of unauthorized persons in restricted areas are additional duties and responsibilities.

The Level II Training Course and Exam is required of all non-commissioned security officers, commissioned security officers and personal protection officers. This training course must be administered by a licensed Level III or Level IV Training School and taught by a licensed Level III or Level IV Instructor.
