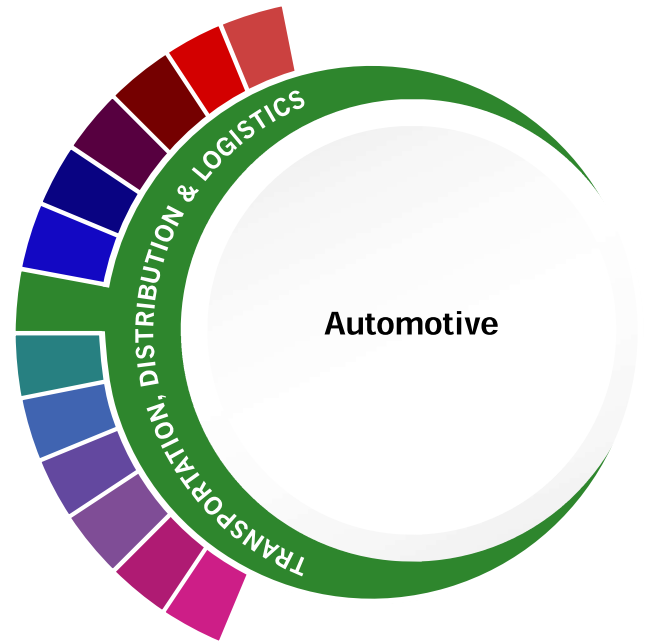
INDUSTRY-BASED CERTIFICATION DESCRIPTION
