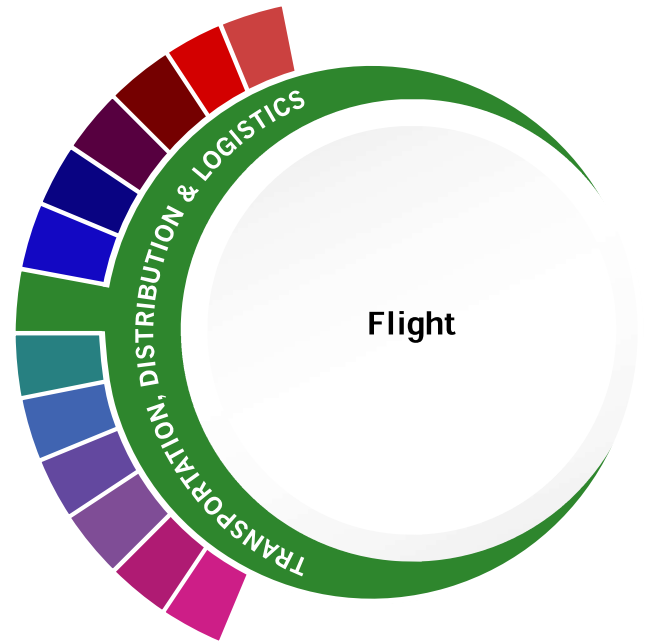


FAA Part 107 Remote Drone Pilot

INDUSTRY-BASED CERTIFICATION DESCRIPTION

The FAA Part 107 Remote Drone Pilot certification exam assesses knowledge and skills related to: applicable regulations relating to small unmanned aircraft system rating privileges, limitations, and flight operation; airspace classification, operating requirements, and flight restrictions affecting small unmanned aircraft operation; aviation weather sources and effects of weather on small unmanned aircraft performance; small unmanned aircraft loading; emergency procedures; crew resource management; radio communication procedures; determining the performance of small unmanned aircraft; physiological effects of drugs and alcohol; airport operations; and maintenance and preflight inspection procedures.
