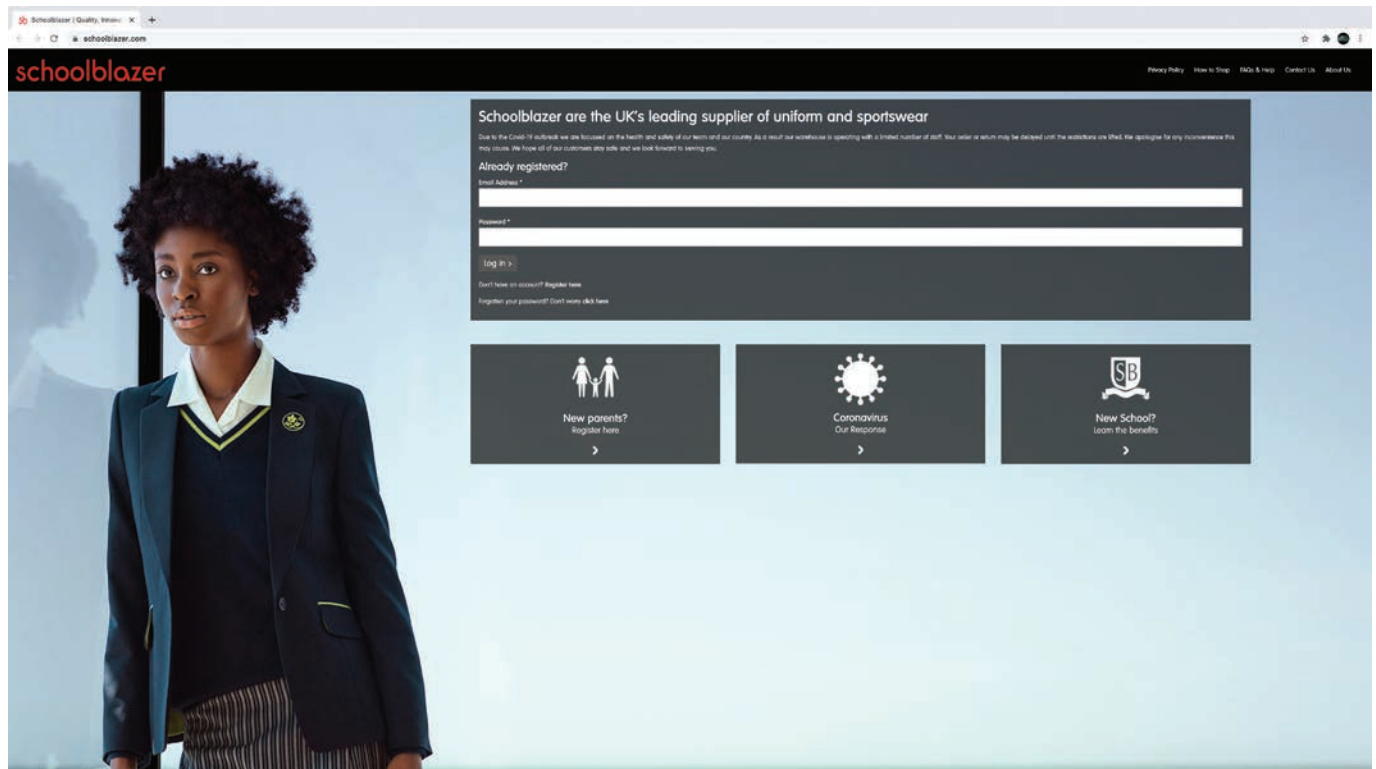

School Uniform

All pupils in the Prep School and Years 7 – 11 of the Senior School must wear school uniform. All official school uniform is available to purchase from School Blazer Limited. School Blazer operates an online shop www.schoolblazer.com

Phased New Sports Kit

Stonar will be phasing in a new Prep and Senior School sports kit in September 2022. The new sports kit will be purchasable from School Blazer from 1 June 2022. During the 2022/23 academic year, pupils may opt to continue to wear the old kit, but from September 2023 the new sports kit will be compulsory for all pupils.

Prep School

Expectations

During the school day pupils in the Prep School must wear school uniform that is clean and of the correct size. All uniform must be clearly labelled.

- The Stonar blazer is worn at all times with uniform
- The stormproof coat may be worn outdoors. Navy gloves and a navy hat may be worn if required
- Shoes must be plain, black and supportive and they must have a back. Sandals and sports shoes are not allowed
- Hair must be of natural colour and long hair must be tied back, hairbands must be navy or black
- Make up and nail varnish are not allowed
- No jewellery is allowed except one small stud in the lobe of each ear and a small cross or religious symbol on a light chain. A plain wrist watch or smart watch may be worn

Sport and Riding

Only the School sports or riding kit should be worn. It should be well maintained and only worn during practical classes.

Senior School

Expectations

All uniform must be clearly labelled with the pupil's name. Pupils in Years 7 – 11 must wear school uniform which is clean, smart and of the correct size. The Stonar blazer is to be worn during the school day, with a white shirt or blouse. Shirts / blouses must be tucked in and top buttons fastened where a tie is worn*. A plain navy blue v-neck jumper may be worn under the blazer.

- Boys must wear a smartly knotted Stonar tie and wear tailored trousers with plain socks in grey, navy or black. Boys in Years 7-8 are permitted to wear tailored charcoal grey shorts from April until September inclusive. Belts must be strictly functional – plain black, suitable for formal trousers.
- Girls must wear a kilt (no shorter than 2” above the knee) with navy blue tights, navy blue knee high socks or white ankle socks.
- Shoes must be plain, black leather with a back and regularly polished, with a heel of not more than 2”. Sandals, pumps and sports shoes are not allowed.
- Hair must be of natural colour, well-groomed and tidy. Hair longer than collar length must be tied back with dark or clear hairbands. Extremes** of fashion are not permitted. Pupils are to be clean shaven with no stubble.
- Make up is not permitted for pupils in Years 7 – 9. Pupils in Years 10 & 11 are permitted to wear discreet natural looking make up. Nail varnish is not allowed.
- No jewellery is allowed except one small stud in the ears and a small cross or other religious symbol on a light chain. A plain wrist watch or smart watch may be worn. Tattoos, spacers or other visible piercings are not permitted.
- In very cold weather a plain dark overcoat, waterproof coat or Stonar jacket may be worn outdoors. Navy / black gloves, scarf and hat may be worn if required.

* Top button may be undone only if permission has been granted to remove the tie.

** Points of clarification on ‘extremes of fashion’

‘number 3’ is the minimum acceptable in terms of shortness, hair should be groomed;

‘artwork’ on the scalp is regarded as a fashion extreme;

‘natural colour’ – this is taken to indicate colours that are natural in shade and tone.

Sport and Riding

The correct School sports kit should be worn for all sporting activities including fixtures. The School riding kit should be worn for all equestrian activities and whilst on the yard Monday to Friday inclusive. Sports and riding kit is not to be worn in School except with prior permission from tutors. No jewellery / piercings may be worn during PE, Games or Riding for Health and Safety reasons.

Overseas Pupils

Pupils coming to Stonar from overseas are expected to have purchased uniform in advance of arriving at the school. Pupils may send their uniform from School Blazer to the school for collection upon arrival. All parcels should be clearly marked with the pupil's name.

Short Stay Pupils (Pupils joining for two terms or less)

- Short stay pupils may borrow a blazer. Girls may also borrow a kilt from the school
- Boys are required to purchase the school tie from School Blazer
- Parents should provide pupils with at least two white blouses / shirts, navy v necked jumpers (and grey tailored trousers for boys)
- For Sports Kit, all short stay pupils are required to purchase the navy midlayer from School Blazer. Parents should also provide plain navy polo shirts/sports t-shirts and training pants as alternatives to the school branded clothing
- Parents may choose to purchase further items of branded school uniform from School Blazer but are not required to do so.

Sixth Form Dress Code

On most school days, the Sixth Form adopt a 'business casual' dress code, the guidelines for which are clarified below. There are frequent occasions when we will want the Sixth Form to wear more 'formal dress' and we expect them to wear a suit on these occasions. The suit guidelines are also found below.

'Business Casual' Guidelines:

'Business casual' can be defined as less formal than a suit, but professional in its nature. It is a mixture between traditional business clothing and a more relaxed style. Here are a few Dos and Don'ts:

- DO pick clothes that fit you and make you look professional, such as tailored blazers, trousers, and dresses.
- DO wear colours that are school-appropriate.
- DO wear closed-toed loafers or low heels.
- DO wear casual trousers, skirts (no more than 2" above the knee), and knee-length dresses.
- DO wear polo shirts, shirts, and blouses.
- DON'T wear logo-ridden shirts and trousers.
- DON'T wear trainers, sandals, leggings or jeans.
- DON'T choose baggy or tight fits.
- DON'T wear sports clothes.
- DON'T wear clothes that are revealing, tight, overly loose, torn, or frayed.
- DON'T wear shorts, halter tops, crop tops, or beachwear.
- DON'T wear flip-flops, clogs, or other unprofessional shoes

Sixth Formers will need a smart suit for 'formal 'dress' as follows:

Girls:

- The Stonar School Suit (skirt or trousers) as available from School Blazer (skirts should be no shorter than just above the knee) or you may buy your own dark blue trouser suit. If buying your own trouser suit, it must be a matching trouser and jacket suit and not a mix and match of non-suit trousers and a different jacket. Suits with a skirt must come from School Blazer.
- A smart collared shirt/blouse.

Boys:

- The Stonar School Suit or boys may buy their own dark blue suit. Trousers should not be ultra-skinny fit.
- A smart collared shirt with a smartly knotted tie.

Expectations for 'Formal Dress':

- 'Shirts' must be tucked in and top buttons fastened*.
- Belts must be strictly functional – plain black, suitable for formal trousers.
- Hosiery or socks should match the suit chosen or be of neutral shade.
- Shoes should be black, clean, smart, regularly polished and suitable for school. The shoes must be supportive with a heel of not more than 3" and they must have a back. Sandals, pumps and sports shoes are not allowed with formal dress.

General Expectations:

- Hair must be of natural colour well-groomed and tidy. Extremes** of fashion are not permitted. Pupils are to be clean shaven with no stubble.
- Sixth Formers are permitted to wear discreet natural looking make up.
- Jewellery should be discreet: an excess of earrings is not permitted. A discreet nose stud is permitted but tattoos, spacers or other visible piercings are not permitted.
- In cold weather a plain dark overcoat, waterproof coat or Stonar jacket may be worn out of doors.
- No jewellery/piercings may be worn during PE, Games or Riding for Health and Safety reasons.

* Top button may be undone only if permission has been granted to remove the tie.
