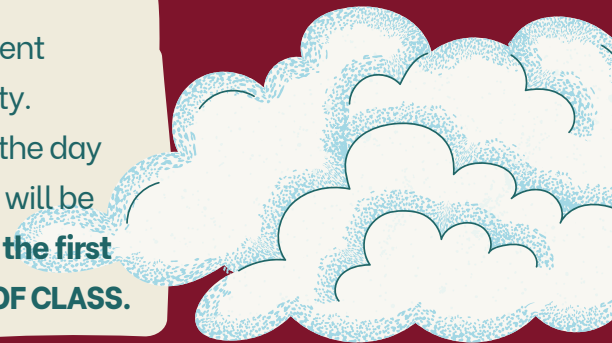

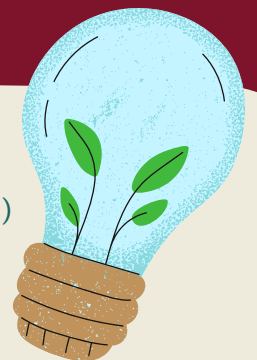
Tuition

Attendance and Credit Policy

Students are required to attend all credit hours of each session. There will be no excused absences for vacations or appointments.

Attendance violation will result in being dropped from the course with no refund given and a loss of credit. It is the sole responsibility of the student athlete to be aware of NCAA requirements (**online courses are NOT NCAA approved**).

Grades

Grades will be uploaded to Synergy before the start of the 2022/2023 school year. Classes are taken for credit ahead, credit recovery or grade improvement. ELA and Math classes may only be taken for credit recovery or grade improvement. Any student registering for SLP in an attempt to improve a grade from a previous course must enroll in the exact same course. The transcript will show that the student has taken the course twice, and both grades will remain on the transcript, but only the higher grade will count toward the GPA. Students cannot substitute general courses for honors or AP courses to improve a grade. Honors and AP courses are not offered during SLP. **Students can only replace a G or H grade with a G or H.**

High School Online Learning

The RCS Summer Learning Program uses a computer-based learning system called Edgenuity that provides students with another medium for achieving academic credit. Edgenuity allows students to work at their own pace while completing necessary academic courses. Rochester Community Schools does not recommend online courses as preparation for an AP course in the same subject area.

How does online learning work?

- Online courses require students to have remote access to a standalone PC with high speed internet access.
- The mentor will use RCS e-mail to communicate with the students on class days.
- The mentor's role is to make sure the student is on pace and to answer general questions. The mentor may not be able to support in content area, but will orient students to course and communicate course requirements.
- The coursework will be accessible the first day of the session.
- Each online course is designed to be the equivalent of approximately 60 hours of instruction.
- Students will take notes as part of their online curriculum. Notebooks are considered a vital part of the online learning course. Students are required to take 1 – 1½ pages of notes per section.
- All coursework, notebooks, and assessments must be completed by 9:00 p.m. the night before the last day of the session. There are no exceptions, extensions or incomplete.
- Students' grades will be based on completing online assessments, their notebooks, and any assigned supplemental materials.

Online Course Tuition (residents only)

Resident– \$275 Per Online Course or \$75 for students who receive free or reduced lunch.

Non-Resident– \$300 per Online Course

Student must complete course in one session (Available all 3 sessions)
