WHAT'S NEW?

Progress continues at Vel Phillips Middle School. The installation of underground storm piping and final water retention work is wrapping up. The more significant visual difference at Vel Phillips Middle School is the walls rising on the West side of the site, and this will continue for many months ahead.

On the New Elementary School design, the OASD and Bray Architects held their first round of user group meetings. As part of this process, staff representatives in each specific space of the building gathered to talk about the needs for their spaces.

PLANNING & DESIGN UPDATE

The Facility Advisory Committee (FAC) 2.0 held its final meeting on May 23. A Board Workshop will take place during the July 13 Regular Board of Education Meeting to review and discuss the Committee's work and findings.

Preliminary planning work for the New Elementary School is underway.

The OASD worked with Bray Architects to distribute an RFP for a traffic study for the New Elementary School; the study is expected to be completed in July. The goal of the study is to be able to improve the traffic flow in the design of that new building. Additionally, an RFP was also issued for a bussing study. The goal of the study is to evaluate the routes and potential boundary shifts that may take place as a result of the new schools and the Northside consolidation process.
