- This partnership equips districts across our state to more equitably support all students postsecondary aspirations, which has become even more important in the wake of COVID-19

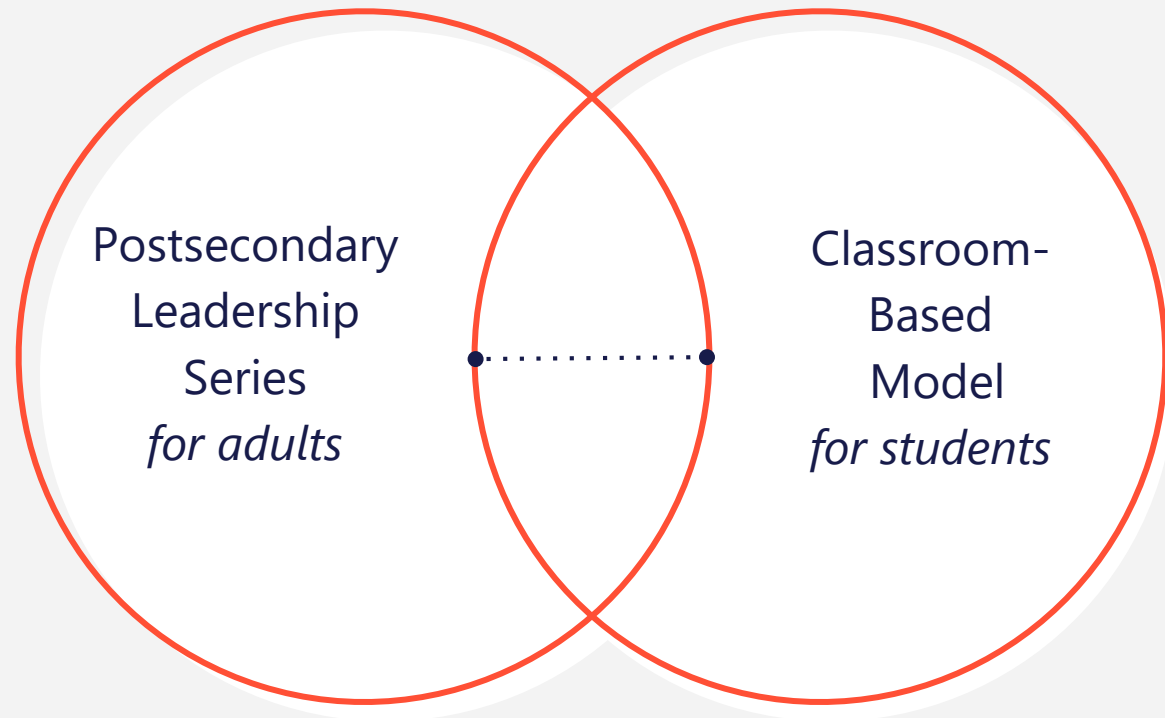
# Dual-track Strategy

## 1 → Building Capacity for Adults

We help school and district leaders assess their current postsecondary readiness, build capacity and community with other leaders, and receive ongoing one-on-one coaching.

## 2 → One-on-one Support for Students

We equip schools to deliver our classroom-based model to students during their Junior and Senior year to ensure they successfully enroll and succeed in their postsecondary path of choice.





## The Postsecondary Leader Series

OneGoal and ISBE have partnered to offer these services to districts and schools across the state leveraging ESSER funds.

### Assess

- 1 Assess your current state with help from a OneGoal facilitator
- 2 Identify key strengths and growth areas
- 3 Discover resources that match your needs
- 4 Monitor progress

#### Format

- + 2-3 sessions per year
- + Available for districts

Join a cohort of school leadership teams. Build capacity through interactive group learning.

### Assembl

- 1 Gain knowledge + skills on a range of key topics with support from a OneGoal facilitator
- 2 Build a cross-district community of practice
- 3 Use data and insights to fuel continuous improvement

#### Format

- + 6 sessions per year on a 3-year cycle
- + 4-5 school teams per cohort

### Advance

- 1 Hands-on, customized support from a OneGoal coach
- 2 Diagnostics to define key priorities + challenges
- 3 Support with stakeholder engagement, strategic planning + coherence mapping
