<p>II. Student Achievement Report</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> a. Data Team Meetings Results- Ms. White shared the results from data team meetings. Some changes that are occurring include first grade changing the way reading groups are carried out, the need for curriculum was brought up, also individual needs to students were able to be discussed. The district will be purchasing Illustrative Mathematics for the entire district. 3rd-5th grades will need a 90 minute block for math next year. Jami will be looking at the resource list for new math curriculum and will contact PTO of any manipulatives the school may need.
