

Peer Teacher Program/Course

Course Description

This course is designed for peer teachers to assist the teacher in daily classroom instruction with their peers. The peer teachers will be an integral part of the differentiation of instruction.

Eligibility Requirements *(to be initialed by Counselor)*

_____ Must be a senior in good standing for graduation

_____ Must sign a Confidentiality Agreement Form—breaking of Confidentiality will require removal from the program for the remainder of the year.

Responsibilities of the Peer Teacher

- Peer Teachers will NOT be permitted to log into Infinite Campus for any reason.
- Peer Teachers should NOT be *required* to “teach” a lesson—they are instructional tutors.
- Peer Teachers are NOT allowed to grade papers.
- Peer Teachers will differentiate instruction for small groups of students per direction from the classroom teacher.

Grade Criteria

- Peer Teachers are to receive a grade of P/F based on the following criteria:
Professional attitude, initiative, willingness to work with peers, leadership qualities, and other criteria set by the classroom teacher
