Dear Berks Catholic School Community,

As Chairperson of the Board of Directors for Berks Catholic High School, I am pleased to announce that Mr. William H. Hess has been appointed Head of School effective July 1, 2021. I would like to express my deep appreciation to all those who participated in the search process, in particular, the Search Committee, and the Berks Catholic Board of Directors for their dedicated efforts throughout the process. In addition, Bishop Schlert, for his approval of the Board's recommendation appointing Mr. Hess as Head of School.

A lifelong Catholic educator, Mr. Hess brings a wealth of experience with him to this new position. He currently serves as our Assistant Principal with primary responsibility as Dean of Students and Athletic Director, a position he has held since 2011. He served in a similar position as Director of Student Life at Holy Name High School from 2002-2011. Previously, he was a Social Studies teacher at Holy Name High School from 1998-2003, also serving as an Assistant Athletic director and coach. Mr. Hess began his career in the Diocese of Allentown at St. Ignatius Loyola Regional School teaching Social Studies in Grades 5-6.

Mr. Hess has twenty-five years of experience in Catholic education, eighteen as an administrator. He holds a Bachelor of Science Degree in Social Studies from Kutztown University and a Master's Degree in Educational Leadership from Alvernia University. Mr. Hess possesses an Instructional II certification in Secondary Education – Social Studies and Principal's Certification from the Pennsylvania Department of Education.

He and his family are members of Holy Rosary Parish in Reading. Mr. Hess is excited to continue to serve Berks Catholic High School in this new role. Please join me and the Berks Catholic Board of Directors in congratulating him as our new Head of School. We wish him all the best!

Also on behalf of the Board of Directors, I would like to extend our profound gratitude to Mrs. Alice Einolf as she retires after 34 years as a Catholic educator, the past two as principal of our school. Prior to her appointment as Principal of BC in 2019, she served as Assistant Principal of Berks Catholic from 2011-2019, and the Director of Studies and a mathematics teacher during her tenure at Holy Name High School from 1998-2011. Mrs. Einolf began her diocesan career as a junior high math teacher at St. Ignatius Loyola Regional School from 1987-1998. We are so grateful for her leadership in Catholic education in Berks County and wish her all the best in her retirement years.



Dear Fellow Alum:





CHECKLIST:

- Form a class reunion committee and solicit volunteers to help.
- Request class list from Berks Catholic.
- Create a Facebook page for your class to help spread the word and locate lost class members.
- Create a class reunion budget. Decide how much you want each attendee to pay and whether or not drinks will be included.
- Choose a venue that meets your budget and pay deposit.
- Set up a pay site such as WePay or PayPal so that people can pay online.
- Share reunion information with Berks Catholic, and we will post on our website.
- Send "Save The Date" postcards or emails at least 6 months prior.
- Print and mail formal invitations or flyers.
- Collect any class reunion memorabilia and yearbooks for display.
- Research and develop deceased classmate tribute.
- Create nametags (Yearbook pictures are a fun addition to nametags).
- Decide on decorations/flowers.
- Create photo slideshow.
- Finalize agenda with a set schedule (when food will be served/when bar will be open/will anyone speak?).
- Finalize headcount and report to venue or caterer.
- Collect contact information from attendees as well as classmates that can't attend.
- Designate someone to take photographs and please share with Berks Catholic for newsletter and website.
- Finalize class reunion budget/consider a class gift with any surplus.
- Update alumni office on any new contact information for your classmates and return any memorabilia.
