**The National Conference for Community & Justice (NCCJ) has 3 exciting opportunities for our students at THS.

1. Anytown Youth Leadership Institute- A week long overnight program that occurs annually in June. During the week, delegates from across the Miami Valley come together to engage in conversation and education about diversity, equity, and inclusion. Delegates also spend time extensively participating in activities surrounding specific DEI issues and topics such as race, gender, ability/disability, class, and allyship. This institute will take place June 12-17, 2022 at Camp Joy in Clarksville, Ohio. We are looking for 8-9 current Freshmen, Sophomores, or Juniors interested in this FREE opportunity.

2. Anytown Youth Leadership Retreat - a biannual overnight weekend program that takes place in both the spring and fall. During the retreat, delegates from across the Miami Valley explore the meaning of leadership and allyship, and discuss what they look like in action. Delegates are also equipped with practical skills to bring about community change, and they choose from various workshops throughout the weekend as they determine how to best foster change with the skills they have learned. There are two planned retreats this year, April 29-May 1 and November 4-6. Both retreats will take place at Camp Cricket Holler in Lebanon. We are looking for 7 current 9-11 graders who would be interested in this FREE opportunity.

3. Teen Summit - provides high school students with resources and skills that they can utilize and prepare them to make changes in their school around topics of diversity, equity and inclusion. Each year a new theme is addressed. This year, the theme is 'Leveling the Playing Field: How Diversity Intersects with Mental Health.' Teen Summit will host 20 High Schools in the Greater Miami Valley region. The Teen Summit encourages students to build networks of passionate youth leaders in their district. As a group, these leaders build projects to impact district and community. This summit will be held Tuesday, April 19th 2022 at the Antioch Shrine in Dayton.
