

Things to Consider:

Academic

- Can your child handle completing a large portion of their work independently?
- Possible affect on GPA and Class Rank.

Social / Emotional

- Your child will, for the most part, be in classes with older students and adults.
- How does your child handle peer pressure?
- Some discussions may be on an adult level that might cause some discomfort.

Graduation Requirements

- No graduation requirement can be waived and all work must be completed (official transcript from the IHE) prior to the THS graduation ceremony in order to participate in said ceremony.

Final College/University Destination

- How will CCP classes impact my intended major?
- What classes will I be left taking my freshman year at my college/university?
- GPA earned may not transfer to another institution.
- *"Don't "telegraph" you won't take college work seriously by earning C's."*

Scheduling

- Every attempt will be made to accommodate your child's schedule at THS.
- It may not be possible for your child to take certain classes at THS while participating in the CCP program.
- Students must participate in a minimum of 6 Carnegie Units of course work.
- Participating IHE's are not required to contact Troy High School if your child drops or is failing a class.

Athletic Eligibility

- Requires an Interim Grade from college instructors
- Online grade book data can be used if a student prints off the grade in the presence of their counselor.
- a running grade or total points earned out of total points currently awarded must be present on the report.
- Athletes are encouraged to take 6 Carnegie Unit classes if at all possible.
- Most athletes are at the state minimum (5 full credit classes) for eligibility when taking CCP classes.

CCP Courses at Troy High School

- Several on campus CCP courses offered via Edison State C.C.
 - ENG121S (Composition 1) is the 'Gateway' English Course.

ACP Courses at Troy High School (Advance College Project)

- ACP students:
 - Have a 2.7 or higher on 4.0 scale
 - Ohio: taking college prep curriculum
 - Should be considered likely to succeed in the course
- Two courses offered via Indiana University-East:
 - ACP CHEM C101/121 Elementary Chemistry / Chem Lab
 - ACP BIOL100 Humans and the Biological World

None of this means anything if you can't transfer credits

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
