Administration Reports

Principal's Report: Mr. Luke Herlache - Field day activities are planned and the kids are excited. The puzzle pieces are being revealed. Each class and each student has the opportunity to earn the removal of a puzzle piece for categories like quiet cafeteria, safe play at recess and being ready to learn in the classroom. There will be a rotation on field day, each class will go around to the different stations. Volunteers are needed. There will be a popcorn read-a-loud, baseball field run, dunk tank, bubble party, sidewalk chalk art fair, Zumba, staff bubble ball battle. There will be about 10 volunteers needed throughout the day. The school is getting an 85 inch display panel for the gym. It will be placed below the score board and be used for things such as assemblies and gym class to model movements. The cost is \$1885 and the total installation is \$8000. Next fall PBIS will be using the "cool rules" model. The first eight days of school will be a boot camp with learning things such as "win-win compromise" language.
