REMIND PROGRAM

Remind is a free service that lets me send quick messages via text, push notifications, or email to everyone involved with the class/school. Parent Access (PA)

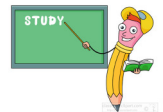
Stay up to date with your child's academic progress by creating a Parent Access Account. With a PA account, parents can view their child's grades online and in real-time. Items such as grades, attendance and teacher comments are available for viewing by parents as soon as they are posted in a teacher's online gradebook. If you have previously created a Parent Access Account, your account will remain active until your child graduates. The only thing you need to update at the beginning of the year is your alert setups. If you have not yet created an account, letters will be sent home in the next few weeks containing the information needed to set up an account.

FREE AND REDUCED LUNCH APPLICATIONS AND INSTRUCTIONAL FEES

Parents, please make sure you have completed and returned the Free and Reduced Price School Meals Application for your child. During the 2017/2018 school year, Ohio Revised Code 3313.642 prohibits districts from charging instructional fees for students eligible for free lunch through this program. This fee waiver applies to



those receiving free (not reduced) lunch prices. To receive the instructional fee waiver, the Sharing Information with Other Programs Form must be completed and returned.

Student tickets for the Urbana High football games will be on sale in the office at East on Friday's only from 2:30 – 3:30pm. Student tickets are \$4.00, and we do not sell adult tickets. These tickets are good for any home football game.

LUNCHROOM NEWS

THE LUNCHROOM AT EAST OFFERS THREE CHOICES FOR LUNCH. PREPAYING ON MONDAY IS HELPFUL BUT YOU MAY PAY ANY DAY YOU CHOOSE. PLEASE MAKE CHECKS PAYABLE TO URBANA CITY SCHOOLS. BREAKFAST IS OFFERED EACH MORNING TO ALL STUDENTS FREE OF CHARGE. THE COSTS THIS YEAR ARE: REGULAR BREAKFAST FREE FOR EVERYONE, REGULAR LUNCH COST \$2.65, REDUCED LUNCH COST IS \$.40 AND MILK IS \$.50.

If a student forgets his or her lunch money, they must call home/work to try to get lunch money before lunch time. *Remember no fast food lunches, and no soda pop are to be brought in and eaten in the cafeteria. (Page 20 Student Handbook)*

REMINDERS

- All visitors (Parents too!) must check in at the office when they enter the school and wear a badge)
- No flip-flop or stacked heel shoes at school. Please see page 16 in the handbook for more information on the elementary dress code.
- If your child is absent from school please call the office (937-653-1453) before 9:15am. You may call the night before or early in the morning and leave a message on the voice mail. This calling policy is for your child's protection.
- There is no supervision on the playground until 8:15am. Students need to arrive once there is supervision.
- All medication must be brought to school by an adult and given to the school nurse or principal. We cannot give medicine without a completed form from your doctor.



ASBESTOS MATERIALS

As per regulation under the Environmental Protection Agency(EPA), Regulation 40CFR part 763, parents and students need to be informed that building materials containing asbestos are located in Urbana City buildings. These materials have been identified through a building inspection and reinspection program as required by the Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHEREA). A copy of the information is located in the Principal's Office and a master copy of the management plan is in the Board of Education Office. The mere presence of asbestos containing materials (ACM) posed no significant health risk. The Urbana City School District has taken appropriate actions as specified in the management plan to minimize any risk.

Child Find Notice:

The Urbana City School District is attempting to locate, evaluate, and identify all children 0 to 21-years-old who are in need of special education and related services residing within the district, including children with disabilities who are homeless or are wards of the state, and children with disabilities attending nonpublic schools as required by the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA).

Disability conditions are defined by IDEA and include visual impairments, hearing impairments, autism, cognitive disabilities, emotional disabilities, orthopedic impairments, multiple disabilities, learning disabilities, traumatic brain injury, or speech and language disabilities.
