Kindergarten screening will be held
May 13, 14, 15, and 16

Screening will be held at the
Urbana Elementary Pk-8 Building,

Parents must bring the following
documentation to the screening:

- * certified birth certificate
- * immunization record
- * parent driver's license
- * proof of residency (utility bill or rental/lease agreement)
- * custody paperwork (if applicable)

Entering kindergarten students
must be age 5 before 8/1/19.

Positive Family Communication, continued

Tips for building this asset

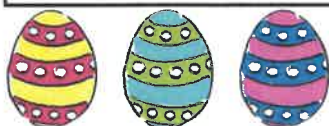
Positive communication also means listening to understand a young person's perspective, not to advocate your position. Be available when young people need you--and even when they think they don't. Take good care of yourself so when your children want to talk, you can give them your full attention.

Also try this...

In your home and family: Make it easy for your child to spend time talking with you. Keep an extra stool or chair in the kitchen, den, home office, or workshop area. When you're in the car together is the perfect time to chat too!

In your neighborhood and community: Ask young people you know caring questions, such as, *What was the best thing about school today? What was the best act in the talent show? Why? Listen* to their answers and respond accordingly.

In your school or youth program: During parent meetings, discuss the importance of positive communication between parents and children.
