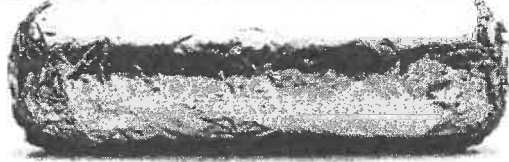

The Urbana City School District offers schoolwide Title 1 services for grades kindergarten through 8th grade. Title 1 services are supported by Federal funding and are designed to ensure that ALL children have a fair, equal, and significant opportunity to obtain high-quality reading and math instruction to become successful learners. Title 1 funding is used to provide additional intervention support for ALL K-8 students.
