What's Happening with PBIS

PBIS is <u>Positive Behavioral Interventions</u> and <u>Supports</u>. All K-5 students have the opportunity to earn points for positive behaviors in the areas of respect, responsibility, and being ready.

Grades K-2: Whole class rewards and individual rewards are being given. Class rewards change each month. For November, students could earn *Crayons for the Classroom, Fort Climbers, It's Showtime (movie), Indoor Recess Kits, Writing supplies,* or *Dr. V. Reads to the Class.* Students "pool" their points to earn one or more classroom rewards. At the end of the month, a PBIS Rewards Store (on a cart) is taken to the learning communities for 3 students per classroom to shop for items with any additional points earned. Grades 3-5: The cart store is going to each classroom once a month. Students are limited to 2 items. Students also have the option to put points in their class bank for a class reward, i.e. *Stinky Feet Day, Pj Day, Crazy Hair Day, Hat Day,* or additional *Tech Time.*

We are HYBRID!

As you are aware, the district moved to the **Hybrid Format** for our families that selected the District Flex Plan. This format started on Monday, 11/30. Hybrid instruction ensures that social distancing of more than 6 feet apart in classrooms, at lunch, and recess is maintained. The remaining dates when students will attend classes face-to-face are:

<u>Group A</u> - December 7, 9, 14, 16 <u>Group B</u> - December 8, 10, 15, 17, 18

Teachers are following their same class schedules. All required assignments are given in paper/pencil format. Under Hybrid, students in grades K-5, will **NOT** receive devices to utilize at home. Students will not be expected to access technology for any of their required assignments. However, teachers may provide enrichment or **optional** activities that are computer or internet based.

ATTENDANCE

The attendance of students on their scheduled Hybrid days is very important since the teacher(s) will be providing instruction to prepare the students for the paper-pencil class assignments that will be brought home. If your child is absent, please continue to notify the school **by 9:15 am** to explain the reason for the absence. Attendance will be documented by attending face-to-face instruction along with the completion of assignments on those days when not face-to-face. The amount of time students will spend on class assignments on days when they are not at school will vary depending on the grade level, subjects, and student ability.




