### What's Happening with PBIS

PBIS = Positive Behavioral Interventions and Support The term "bullying" is often used by students and parents to describe someone's behavior. It is important to know that the majority of bullying and harmful behavior happens in order to get attention, praise, or social status from the victim. In order to be considered bullying.

by-standers, peers, or even the victim. In order to be considered bullying, the behavior must be aggressive and repeated over time and include:

- **An Imbalance of Power:** Kids who bully use their power—such as physical strength, access to embarrassing information, or popularity—to control or harm others. Power imbalances can change over time and in different situations, even if they involve the same people.
- **Repetition:** Bullying behaviors happen more than once (repeated) or have the potential to happen more than once.

Bullying includes actions such as making threats, spreading rumors, attacking someone physically or verbally, and excluding someone from a group on purpose.

# Kindergarten Registration for 2021-2022

Ohio legislation (ORC 3321.01) mandates attendance in and successful completion of kindergarten before a child enters first grade. Urbana City Schools offers all day, every day kindergarten for children turning five (**5**) <u>before</u> August 1, 2021. If you have or know of anyone who has a child who fits this description, we are encouraging parents to register him/her for kindergarten <u>NOW</u>.

Due to Covid restrictions this year, kindergarten registration and screening times will take place in two steps at two locations.

**Step #1:** Pick up a registration packet at the **Urbana City Schools Board Office** at <u>711 Wood Street, Urbana</u>, Monday-Friday between the hours of 8:00 am-3:30 pm. A screening appointment will be made for your child at that time.

Step #2: Return all COMPLETED forms from your registration packet and bring them along with the following documentation: child's certified birth certificate, child's immunization record, parent/guardian driver's license, proof of residency (utility bill or rental/lease agreement), and custody paperwork (if applicable) to your child's scheduled kindergarten screening appointment. Screening will take place at the Urbana Elementary PK-8 building, <u>1673 US Hwy 68 South, Urbana</u> and will take approximately 15-20 minutes. In order to practice social distancing, parents will wait in an assigned area until their child is finished with testing.

If you have any questions, please call the Elementary school office at (937) 653-1453, Monday-Friday between the hours of 8:00 am - 4:00 pm. You **must** bring completed registration forms and documents to your child's scheduled screening appointment. Screening dates are: **April 28, 29, 30** *and* **May 17, 18.** 

### FACIAL COVERINGS/MASKS FOR STUDENTS

Many students are arriving at school without a face covering/mask. Governor Dewine issued a statewide mask order/mandate in July, 2020 that stated "All individuals in Ohio MUST wear facial coverings in public at all times when: at an indoor location that is not a residence, and, outdoors but unable to maintain a six-foot social distance from people who are not household members."

If your child is provided a white, cotton/cloth mask from the school, we ask that you please wash and reuse it over and over again.

Reminder: for the health and safety of your child and others, facial coverings should fit your child's face properly and cover the nose and chin.



### <u>AIR TESTING</u>

State Testing is just around the corner! There are 2 parts for each test. All testing students will receive a hot breakfast on the morning of testing (as long as they arrive at school ahead of time at 8:40 am). Testing will begin at approximately 9:15 am. Please make sure your child gets a good night's sleep and arrives at school on time.
