Social Emotional Learning (SEL) Ohio Standards Educators and school counselors have specific standards they

must meet for traditional, core instruction. The U.S. Department of Education defines standards as "set goals for what students should know and be able to do while learning academic content." In a sense, social-emotional learning (SEL) standards are similar. They provide a shared language with which educators can discuss what students should be learning from their SEL curriculum. Standards help determine developmentally, grade-appropriate goals for students and teachers to work toward. According to the Ohio Department of Education, social-emotional learning standards provide a continuum of development across five (5) SEL areas: Self-Awareness, Self-Management, Social Awareness, Relationship Skills, and Responsible Decision-Making. Aligning this SEL philosophy with our PBIS action plan can make a significant impact on both our students and school. Our elementary students are reminded daily of our PBIS Climber Code:

Kindergarten Registration is going on NOW!

Urbana City Schools offers all day, every day kindergarten for children turning five (5) *before* August 1, 2021. If you have or know of anyone who has a child who fits this description, we are encouraging parents to register him/her for kindergarten NOW.

Due to Covid restrictions this year, kindergarten registration and screening times will take place in two steps at two locations.

Step #1: Pick up a registration packet at the Urbana City Schools Board Office at 711 Wood Street, Urbana, Monday-Friday between the hours of 8:30 am-3:30 pm. A screening appointment will be made for your child at that time.

Step #2: Return all COMPLETED forms from your registration packet and bring them along with the following documentation: child's certified birth certificate, child's immunization record, parent/guardian driver's license, proof of residency (utility bill or rental/lease agreement), and custody paperwork (if applicable) to your child's scheduled kindergarten screening appointment. Screening will take place at the Urbana Elementary PK-8 building, 1673 US Hwy 68 South, Urbana and will take approximately 15 minutes. In order to practice social distancing, parents will wait in an assigned area until their child is finished with testing (no consultations at this time).

If you have any questions, please call the Elementary school office at (937) 653-1453, Monday-Friday between the hours of 8:00 am - 4:00 pm. You must bring completed registration forms and documents to your child's scheduled screening appointment. Screening dates are: April 28, 29, 30 and May 17, 18.
