CHROMEBOOK RETURN

GRADING INFORMATION

Semester credit may not be granted unless a student attains passing grades in 2 of 3 grades (1st and 2nd nine weeks and semester exam or 3rd and 4th nine weeks and final exam) regardless of total points earned. See entire grading policies on page 13 in the student handbook.

PROMOTION POLICIES

The total number of credits earned determines your grade level. You will be promoted to the next grade when you have accumulated the following credits.

SUBSTITUTES NEEDED ACROSS DISTRICT

Substitute teachers need to have a bachelor's degree and completed background check to be certified. Paraprofessionals work in the classroom to assist with the instruction of students and to be certified must have an associate's degree or pass the certification test along with the completion of a background check. Associates help out with lunch, playground, and bus duties and to be certified must be a high school graduate and complete a background check.

Substitute bus drivers are also needed. These positions require specialized training and certifications along with a background check.
