Health as a New Credit Option

When:

Required registration/orientation for parent/guardian **and** student (one of four options)
June 4th at 7:00 pm, June 10th at 5:30 pm, June 13th at 1:00 pm or June 17th at 9:00 am

Summer School dates: June 19th through August 1st
Full credit courses must be completed by August 1st
Half credit only courses must be completed 3 weeks from start date for refund option

Session dates:

Specific dates and times for work sessions are attached or on the back
Two-hour work sessions in the school setting
Additional time will be expected to complete coursework outside of the work sessions

Where:

Registration/Orientation –Urbana High School Cafeteria on dates listed above
Summer Work Sessions - Urbana High School – Rooms 218/219

Cost:

The cost of summer school is \$75.00 per one-half (0.5) credit and a fee waiver is not available; however, students may submit a written request for a \$50 refund if they successfully complete the course in the specified time listed above. A full credit course would cost \$150.00 with a possible \$100 refund under the same circumstances. The full cost of summer school must be paid no later than the final registration/orientation on June 17th. There are no waivers for summer school costs.

Additional Information:

Due to the shorter summer this year, two (2) half credits or one (1) full credit of recovery will be permitted during summer school. English and math credit recovery must be completed prior to science or social studies. If a student completes one (1) credit with additional summer school weeks remaining, an additional half or full credit option may be permitted at the discretion of the summer school teacher(s) or administrator.

Students must work at the school a minimum of 12 hours in work sessions for a one-half (0.5) credit course or a minimum of 24 hours in work sessions for a one-credit (1) course and will also be expected to complete coursework outside of this time (home, library, etc.) Students must also complete all course requirements and obtain a passing average to receive the associated credit.

Students will need to use their school-issued Chromebook when at school. *If the student was a free or leave at school option for the Chromebook and they need a computer to complete their coursework at home, the parent will be required to sign a document agreeing to be financially responsible for any damage to or loss of the device, prior to the student being able to take a Chromebook home.*

Full credit in each is available or a semester option for those who only need one semester:
