RENEWAL LEVY ON NOVEMBER 5th BALLOT

Our 5.9 mill operating levy expires at the end 2020 and is on the November 5th general election ballot for renewal. Passage of this issue will not result in a tax increase.

This levy, first passed in 2000, provides almost \$1.2 million dollars in support for the day-to-day operations of the District. Instead of renewing for a five-year term as in the past, the Board of Education is requesting this levy be renewed for a continuing period of time. If supported, voters will not need to renew this levy in the future.

OHIO GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS CHANGING

Ohio is in the process of moving to permanent graduation requirements for the Class of 2023 and beyond. In the meantime, there are options for prior classes, including the Classes of 2020, 2021, and 2022. Additional communication will be shared throughout the school year related to these requirements. ACADEMIC SUCCESS

A primary goal for Urbana High School is academic success for all students. Our staff and administration are committed to assisting all students in their pursuit of academic success. A few of our specific efforts in this area are increased communication with parents and students through email and/or Remind*, promotion of Parent and Student Access (gradebook viewing) for monitoring student progress, and Academic Aide (teacher supervised and assisted homework and study time) after school on Mondays, Tuesdays, and Thursdays.

PARENT ACCESS

If you have not yet set up your Parent Access account, information was recently sent home explaining how to do so. All parents are encouraged to create a Parent Access account. Once created, this account will remain active until graduation. Video directions explaining how to set up an account can be found on the Parent Access website <https://pa.woco-k12.org/>. If your account is already set up, don't forget to reset your Missing Assignment and Low Marks alerts for the 2019-2020 school year. These alerts can be set by logging into your Parent Access Account and then clicking on "Alert" on the left-hand side. SEARCH INSTITUTE ATTITUDES AND BEHAVIOR SURVEY

On October 15th, our school in partnership with the Champaign County Drug Free Youth Coalition will be surveying our youth. We are seeking to survey UHS students in grade 10 to determine local youth needs and strengths and to seek to better understand the attitudes and behaviors of our student body.

The survey focuses on the strengths and supports that youth have and need in their lives. This survey will help our school and the Coalition work to ensure that young people in our community have the opportunities they need to be successful in life. The survey focuses on young people's own perceptions of their attitudes and behaviors.

Additional Information:

- 1 Students will complete the survey during their Biology class on Tuesday, October 15.
2. On average, the survey takes less than 40 minutes to complete.
3. Youth will be told that their participation is voluntary and that they can skip items if they so choose.
4. The survey is not a test and there are no consequences if your child chooses not to participate. Non-participating youth will asked to sit quietly and read or do homework while the survey is administered.

6. Please give serious consideration for your child to participate in this study. The value of a study of this kind depends upon the participation of many youth.
