TEST OF EMERGENCY NOTIFICATION SYSTEM

On Thursday, January 30th at approximately 5:30 pm we will be sending out an "emergency" notification call as a test. When we use the emergency designation instead of informational, the notifications are sent to your primary number plus up to three additional phone numbers and four email addresses that you designate in the system. If you would like to check, change, or add additional numbers or emails you can do so by calling the PreK-12 Notification Family Hotline at 1-800-846-4976 from your primary number and follow the telephone prompts. If your primary number is not recognized by the system, please contact the school office at 937-653-1412. [See the attached letter for more specific instructions.]

UHS PARENT-TEACHER CONFERENCES

TESTING

Wednesday, February 25, 2020 is a required testing day for SOPHOMORES and JUNIORS.

JUNIORS will be taking the state-funded ACT test. The ACT test is a curriculum-based education and career planning tool for high school students that assesses the mastery of college readiness standards.

SOPHOMORES will be taking the ASVAB test. The ASVAB student testing program, also known as the ASVAB Career Exploration Program (CEP), is used for career exploration and is given in high schools.

With a signed parent permission form on file, sophomore and junior students will be permitted to be excused when all testing is completed around midday. **Freshman** and **Seniors** will <u>NOT</u> report to school on this date.

Dear Parent/Guardian:

The Urbana City School District has implemented the PreK-12 Notification system as part of our overall safety plan. This telephone calling system will allow us to quickly communicate delays, closings, emergencies and other information to families in the district.

In the event of a delay or closing, calls will be sent to the home phone number we have on file. If a decision is made in the evening for the next day, the calls will typically be started before 9:00 p.m. We will still publicize delay and closing information on local radio and television stations in case there is a failure of the notification system. If you do not receive a call during a delay or closing, please call the office of the school your child attends.

In the event of an emergency, PreK-12 Notification can notify you at up to four phone numbers and four e-mail addresses. (More information on how to enter an e-mail address is on the second page of this document.) You will need to register with PreK-12 Notification. It is quick and easy. Just call the PreK-12 Notification Family Hotline at **1-800-846-4976** from your primary phone number. Simply follow the telephone prompts to manage your list. **For security reasons, you must call from your primary phone number to access your contact list.** Once you have your pin code, then you can go to http://www.prek12notification.com and login to add phone numbers and email addresses. If you do not have access to a computer, you can call your school and they can add the contact information for you.

When we send a message, the caller ID will always identify that the call is coming from your child's school or the district office. Messages will be left on answering machines or in voicemail. A total of four attempts will be made to complete the call if there is no answer.

If at any time you change your phone number, please let your child's building secretary know so we have correct contact information for you. If you have any questions about the system, please call the office of the school where your student attends.

PreK-12 Notification Email and Text Messaging

Through the e-mail capabilities of the PreK-12 Notification system text messages can also be sent. The message will notify you to call 1-800-846-4976 to hear the recorded message that was sent. You will then need to enter the 10-digit phone number of your primary phone on file in the school office. If you would like to add texting you can enter an e-mail address with your 10-digit phone number followed by the appropriate carrier information listed below. Please contact your carrier if it is not listed below. You can also test the e-mail to text function by sending an e-mail using your cell phone number & carrier information
