## **EMERGENCY MEDICAL AUTHORIZATION FORMS (EMA)**

This form is required by law and provides us with instructions on how to care for your child in the event of an emergency. Students will not be allowed to participate in field trips and other activities until this form is returned. Students were given this form during schedule pick-up. Extra forms are available in the main office. If information changes during the school year, please contact the office at (937) 653-1412.

## ABSENCE REPORTING

A parent, or guardian, must phone the school attendance office (653-1414) before 9:00 a.m. to report student absences. If no information is received, a phone call will be made between 9:00 and 9:30 a.m. to the primary contact number on the school file.

# FREE AND REDUCED LUNCH APPLICATIONS AND INSTRUCTIONAL FEES

Please make sure you have completed and returned the Free and Reduced Price School Meals Application for your student. During the 2020-2021 school year, Ohio Revised Code 3313.642 prohibits districts from charging instructional fees for those eligible for free lunch through this program. This fee wavier applies to those receiving free (not reduced) lunch prices. To receive the instructional fee wavier, the Sharing Information with Other Programs Form must be completed and returned.

NEW THIS YEAR -In addition the free breakfast program offered by the Urbana City School District, FREE LUNCH is available for ALL students starting on Monday, September 14th. Meals must meet the required components to be free of charge. Extra entrees and a la carte items will still be available for purchase. This extension of the free meal program from the USDA is scheduled to end on December 31, 2020, or when funding runs out. If you have not already done so, please make sure you still complete the free and reduced meal application for 2020-21. This process is required to be eligible for the student fee waiver.

# STUDENT FEES

Students may pay school fees in the main office during lunch or after school. Fees (and lunches) may also be paid through the website by clicking on lunch menu, choosing the pay online option, then following the prompts. Grade cards will be held and course credit cannot be certified until fees have been paid. Students will also not be allowed to attend school dances or receive a work permit until fees are paid or a payment plan is arranged. Fees are required to be paid in full to attend Prom and to participate in the graduation ceremony.

# COURSE DROP POLICY

If a student withdraws from a class after the 15<sup>th</sup> day of a yearlong class or the 8<sup>th</sup> day of a semester class, it will be recorded as a withdraw/failing (WF). Withdrawal from a class before the end of the 15<sup>th</sup> day of a yearlong class or the 8<sup>th</sup> day of a semester class will be recorded as withdrawn (W). Parent and school approval is needed to withdraw from a class. The option of dropping a class for a study hall is available on a limited basis at this time due to a limited number of available study hall seats.

#### PARENT ACCESS

Stay up to date with your child's academic progress by creating a Parent Access Account. With a PA account, parents can view their child's grades online and in real-time. Items such as grades, attendance and teacher comments are available for viewing by parents as soon as they are posted in a teacher's online gradebook. If you have previously created a Parent Access Account, your account will remain active until your child graduates. The only thing you need to update at the beginning of the year is your alert setups. #### **REMIND**

The staff at Urbana City Schools will be using Remind to share pertinent information with parents. Remind allows our staff to share information through messages that can be received by text, email or through the Remind app. Please make sure your mobile number is updated with your child's office to ensure that the Remind system works properly. #### MASKS AND SOCIAL DISTANCING

As a part of our district restart plan and by order of the state health department and governor's office, masks must be worn at all times while on the school bus, on school property, and throughout the school day except for designated mask breaks as authorized by school personnel or when actively eating at breakfast or lunch. Social distancing of 6 feet or more is to be followed in every setting where possible. When not possible, as much distance as possible should be maintained.

#### HEALTH ASSESSMENT BEFORE SCHOOL

Students, with assistance from their parents, should conduct a health assessment prior to reporting to school. Students with COVID-related symptoms should stay home. Please contact the main office at (937) 653-1412 to report absences and symptoms before 9:00 am. COVID-related symptoms can be found on the CDC (Center for Disease Control) or ODH (Ohio Department of Health) websites. If you have questions, please contact our UHS nurse at (937) 653-1433.

#### **BOOKBAGS INSTEAD OF LOCKERS**

Student lockers will not be utilized at this time; therefore, all students need to bring a book bag for carrying necessary school items. Students with medical needs will need to speak with the nurse or principal regarding these concerns. If brought to school, cell phones must be turned off and placed in the book bag during school hours.

## ARRIVAL AND BREAKFAST

Students who do not use bus transportation or do not participate in the school-wide free breakfast program should not arrive until 7:25 am and report directly to their first period class by the closest door - #1, #10, #13, #14, #15 or #16

Students arriving by bus or participating in the free breakfast for all program should arrive between 7:00 and 7:25 am. Students who have a first period class on the first floor of the Academic Wing (200 classrooms, except for 206) will enter door #15 (NW Academic Wing) or door #13 (East Lawn Avenue entrance) to get their breakfast in the Extended Learning Area by rooms 219/220 and report directly to their first period classroom. Students who have a first period class in rooms 160, 160B, or 161 will enter the entry doors #1 (main entrance) or #13 (East Lawn Avenue entrance) and get their breakfast from the cafeteria/kitchen and then report to their first period classroom. Students who have a first period class in room 206, the gym or on the second floor of the Academic Wing (300 classrooms) will enter the entry doors #1 (main entrance) or #13 (east lawn avenue entrance), and get their breakfast from the cafeteria/kitchen and sit two to a table in the cafeteria.

## HYBRID - A/B GROUPINGS IF NEEDED DURING 2020-21

We are beginning the school year on the five days a week All-In learning plan; however, we have to be ready to shift to a Hybrid plan (limited days per week) or a Remote Learning plan (fully online) if necessary during the school year. All students have been assigned an "A" or "B" grouping for the school year. IF we transition to a Hybrid plan then Group A students will attend school on Mondays, Wednesdays, and every other Friday. Group B students will attend school on Tuesdays, Thursdays and every other Friday. If you are not aware of your assigned group, please contact the high school main office at (937) 653-1412.

# **CHROMEBOOKS**

All HS students should have received their school-issued Chromebook at this time. Students are reminded to bring their Chromebook fully-charged to school every day. Chromebook payments for the 2020-21 school year are due by the end of the First Quarter (October 23, 2020).

### STUDENT PARKING PASSES

To park on school property, students must apply for and receive a UHS parking pass. The parking passes are \$20 for the school year or \$10 per semester. Applications are available in the main office.

#### PICTURE DAY

Picture Day for the High School has been postponed to the Spring for the 2020-21 school year.

#### URBANA CITY SCHOOLS ATHLETIC TICKETING INFORMATION

The Urbana Athletic Department is moving to online ticketing for all HOME athletic events this fall. There will be several away contests that will also have online only ticketing available, depending on individual district policy. Due to capacity limits as ordered by the Ohio Department of Health, there will be limits on the number of spectators allowed to attend each event.

Urbana athletes and band members will be given a pass code to gain access to the allotted number of tickets. This information will come from the athletic department and/or coaches and directors. The athletic department WILL NOT be taking cash sales at the gate this fall. Tickets may only be purchased via the online ticketing site. THERE WILL BE NO PASSES OF ANY KIND ACCEPTED AT THIS TIME.

Tickets will be able to be purchased online at www.urbanacityschools.org through the Ticketing link on the left-hand side of the page. Find the event you wish to attend, click on get tickets, enter the passcode (if required) and follow the steps to purchase the tickets. Tickets will be mailed to the purchaser's email address. Tickets purchased via the online site can be scanned from your mobile device at the gate or you can choose to print them on paper and have them scanned at the gate.

There will be convenience fees charged by the platform that manages the ticketing site. These fees are collected by the ticketing management company and DO NOT go to Urbana City Schools. While we realize this may not be ideal or well-liked, this does allow for contactless transactions as recommended by the Ohio Department of Health.


