MAKE UP DAY

SUMMER PE

Summer PE registration is officially open! Summer PE will run June 3rd through June 22nd. Forms with all details may be picked up in the main office. Applications turned in after May 20th will be accepted if space is available; Otherwise, students will be placed on a waiting list. SUMMER SCHOOL

Urbana High School will be having Summer School for students who have failed a first or second semester course (Credit Recovery). There will also be an option for Health as a new credit. Summer School is scheduled for June 14th through July 15th. The program is mainly online, however work sessions and assessments will occur in-person with licensed teachers. PROMOTION POLICY

The student's year in high school along with the total number of credits earned determines the grade level. The student will be promoted to the next grade when he/she meets the following criteria:

Freshmen (grade 9) - First year of HS or any student with less than 5 credits

Sophomores (grade 10) - Completed one year of HS and has at least 5 credits

Juniors (grade 11) - Completed two years of HS and has at least 11 credits

Seniors (grade 12) - Completed three years of HS and has at least 17 credits

SEMESTER EXAMS

Underclassman Exams are scheduled for May 27th, May 28th and June 1st. Semester and final exams for high school level courses are not eligible for reassessment. Students who do not return a parental permission form (attached) completed and signed to the main office by Friday, May 21st will be required to be in attendance from 7:35 a.m. to 2:37 p.m. each exam day. Extra permission forms are available in the main office. Buses will run at the normal time. Students who ride a bus home will be required to attend the afternoon study hall. Students may not leave school property and return to ride a school bus. All absences for exam periods must be approved through the high school office. Unexcused absences will result in a failing score on the exam, as there is no reassessment option for exams.

Exam Exemptions

Students may qualify for up to two (2) exam exemptions in January and up to two (2) exams in May.

Exemption Qualification - Quarter grades of A's or B's AND teacher permission

CHROMEBOOK RETURN

We will be collecting all Chromebooks that have not been paid for in full Wednesday, May 26, 2021 through June 1, 2021. The Chromebooks will be stored at school over the summer and returned to students when they return from summer break and the payment plan is up-to-date. Chromebooks not returned will be considered lost and a \$200 fee will be added to your child's school fees. The charger is required to be returned with the Chromebook and will be stored with the device. There will be a \$25 fee for a lost charger. A lost Chromebook or a lost charger does not qualify for the fee waiver. If you had intended to purchase the Chromebook, so that it may be kept over the summer, the remaining balance will need to be paid by Tuesday, June 1, 2021. Urbana High School On-line Learning Credit Recovery Health as a New Credit Option

When:

Required registration/orientation for parent/guardian and student

June 10^{th} – small group appointment times 1:00-3:00 and 4:30-6:00

Summer School dates: June 14th through July 15th

Session dates:

Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday each week

Two-hour work sessions in the school setting: 9 – 11 am and/or 12 – 2 pm

In order to complete coursework on time, students will need to work outside of the in-person work session times.

Where:

Registration/Orientation – Urbana High School Cafeteria Summer Work Sessions - Urbana High School – Rooms 218/219

Cost:

The cost of summer school is \$75.00 per one-half (0.5) credit and fee waivers are not available for summer school; however, students may submit a written request for a \$50 refund if they successfully complete the course in the specified time listed above. The full cost of summer school is due at the registration /orientation on June 10th.

Additional Information:

English or Math credit recovery will be the priority for summer school unless the only recovery needed is in science or social studies.

Students must work at the school a minimum of 12 hours in work sessions for a one-half (0.5) credit course, complete all assessment in-person as well as complete additional work time at home. Students must also complete all course requirements and obtain a passing average to receive the credit.

Students will need to use their school-issued Chromebook when at school. If the student was a free or leave at school option for the Chromebook and they need a computer to complete their coursework at home, the parent will be required to sign a document agreeing to be financially responsible for any damage to or loss of the device, prior to the student being able to take a Chromebook home.

All summer school students will be expected to follow COVID protocols while in attendance at the in-person work sessions.

EXAM POLICIES

- 1) Per district grading and assessment guidelines, semester and final exams for high school level courses are **NOT** eligible for reassessment.
- 2) Students who have study hall/lunch during the first or last exam period of the day may be excused with a completed permission slip. Students who do not return a parental permission form completed and signed to the <u>ATTENDANCE/MAIN OFFICE</u> by <u>FRIDAY</u>, <u>MAY 21st</u> will be required to be in attendance from 7:35 am to 2:37 pm each exam day. (See page two for exam exemption and permission form.) If students are not excused for early dismissal, they will report to the HS Study Hall for their lunch period (4th, 5th or 6th) and the afternoon Study Hall. Tutorials will report to their regularly assigned location.
- 3) Students may NOT leave the building if they have an exam during the first and last exam periods and study hall in the middle. They must report to their assigned study hall. (i.e. Students will not be allowed to take an exam, leave and then return for an exam.)
- 4) Students will not be dismissed early from exam periods. Attendance will be required for the entire exam period.
- 5) Buses will run at the normal time. Students who ride the bus home will be required to attend the afternoon study hall. Students may not leave school property and return to ride a school bus.
- 6) All absences for exam periods must be approved through the high school office and a doctor's excuse may be needed. Exams must be taken during their scheduled period.
- 7) Unexcused absences will result in a failing score on the exam, as there is no reassessment option for exams.
- 8) Students who are excused by the office during an exam will be required to take exams during the exam make-up period.
- 9) Students may qualify for **up to** two (2) exam exemptions in January and **up to** two (2) exam exemptions in May/June. Exam exemptions may occur in January or in May/June, but may not accumulate if not used in January. Exemption Qualification Quarter grades of As or Bs <u>AND</u> **teacher permission.**
- 10) If school is cancelled, the exam schedule will continue from the point of interruption the next day school is in session.
- 11) Students may not change exam periods without approval of the administration.
- 12) **IF** school is <u>delayed</u> on an exam day, the following schedule will be used. Remind and email will be sent with the specific details if this is implemented.
