UHS PARENT-TEACHER CONFERENCES

Urbana High School's Fall parent -teacher conferences are scheduled for Monday, November 1 and Thursday November 4 during the hours of 3:00 – 6:30pm. CHROMEBOOKS

Students are reminded to bring their Chromebook fully-charged to school every day. Chromebook payments for the 2021-22 school year are due by the end of the First Quarter (Today, October 15, 2021). If you haven't yet made your payment please do so as soon as possible.

MASKS AND SOCIAL DISTANCING

On Tuesday, September 22, 2021, The Urbana City School District Board of Education took action to implement a universal face mask requirement for all students and staff in the school buildings starting on Monday, September 27, 2021. All guests and visitors will also be required to wear a face mask when inside of the school buildings. A physician's statement is required for a medical exemption. More information is available on the District's website at <u>www.urbanacityschools.org</u>. Social distancing of 3 feet or more is to be followed in every setting where possible. When distancing is more difficult to achieve, as much distance as possible should be maintained.

ASSIGNMENTS DURING ABSENCES/QUARANTINES

Due to careful health checks before coming to school and the need for quarantines and isolations related to COVID-19, students may be missing more days of school than normal. If a student is absent for minor illness or quarantine/isolation, we do expect students to continue to stay current on their assignments and any assessments that are permitted to be done from home. When absent, students should email their teachers and check their Google Classroom accounts daily.

PARENT ACCESS

We now have an app available for Parent Access. In the Google Play Store or Apple App Store, search for "Progressbook Parent and Student" to find and download the mobile app. If you already have an account- tap login, choose Urbana City Schools, tap go, enter your username and password and tap sign in. Students will follow the same directions but will tap Students Sign in with Google. If you have a registration key and need to create an account- open the app, tap login, choose Urbana City Schools, tap go, scroll down to the New to Progressbook? section, tap create account, on the next screen tap New Parent Account and follow the prompts on the screen to complete registration. <u>REMIND</u>

Parents are completely in control of their Remind accounts! You can login to Remind through the app on your smartphone or through the web at <u>remind.com</u>. Once you are logged in, you can change your notification preferences. You can add, remove, or edit your cell phone number and email address as well as adjust your app and desktop notification preferences via your Remind dashboard. On the web: Login to your Remind account on a computer (you will use your cell number or email to login), click your name in the upper left corner and then click on Account Settings. Select the Notification Preferences tab. Set your preferred way to receive notifications. Via Android: Log into the app on your phone. Click on the three vertical dots in the upper right corner of the screen. Click on Account. Click on the gear in the top right and choose Notifications. Via IOS: In the app, tap the gear icon in the upper left corner of the screen. Choose Push (the Remind logo pops up at the top of your screen if you receive a message), or double check your cell phone number and email address and save those preferences. STUDENT PARKING PASSES

To park on school property, students must apply for and receive a UHS parking pass. The parking passes are \$20 for the school year or \$10 per semester. Applications are available in the main office.

URBANA CITY SCHOOLS ATHLETIC TICKETING INFORMATION

The Urbana Athletic Department is continuing to do online ticketing for all HOME athletic events this fall. There will be several away contests that will also have online only ticketing available, depending on individual district policy. The Athletic Department WILL be taking cash sales at the gate this fall. At this time, there are no capacity limits. However, the attendance and ticketing policies are subject to change.

Tickets will be able to be purchased online at <u>www.urbanacityschools.org</u> through the <u>Ticketing</u> for <u>Games</u> and <u>Events</u> link on the left-hand side of the page. Find the event you wish to attend, click on get tickets, and follow the steps to purchase the tickets. Tickets will be sent to the purchaser's email address. Tickets purchased via the online site can be scanned from your mobile device at the gate or you can choose to print them on paper and have them scanned at the gate. You can also use the Hometown Fan app to organize your tickets and passes.

There will be convenience fees charged by the platform that manages the ticketing site. These fees are collected by the ticketing management company and DO NOT go to Urbana City Schools.

PBL



The free Student Financial Aid application is now open. The FAFSA is a vital part of the financial aid process, as it allows students to apply for federal and state grants, federal student loans and federal work-study opportunities. In addition, most colleges require the FAFSA as part of their scholarship application process. We will be offering a virtual Financial Aid information session in conjunction with Wittenberg University on October 20th at 7:30pm for any senior who is planning to attend college next year. A financial aid counselor from Wittenberg will discuss the financial aid and FAFSA process as well as answer any questions families may have.
