Option #1: White Cap & Gown ordered through Jostens

- **White or Black** dress shoes (no flip flops, tennis shoes, Toms, Keds, Crocs, Birkenstocks, etc.)
- **White** dress or white skirt/pants and blouse/shirt (no patterns, capris or leggings)

Option #2: Maroon Cap & Gown ordered through Jostens

- **Black** dress pants (no cargo pants or khaki style pants) with plain white shirt, and dark tie
- **Black** dress shoes with black socks (no flip flops, tennis shoes, Toms, Keds, Crocs, Birkenstocks, etc.)

PROMOTION POLICY

The student's year in high school along with the total number of credits earned determines the grade level. The student will be promoted to the next grade when he/she meets the following criteria:

Freshmen (grade 9) – First year of HS or any student with less than 5 credits

Sophomores (grade 10) – Completed one year of HS and has at least 5 credits

Juniors (grade 11) – Completed two years of HS and has at least 11 credits

Seniors (grade 12) – Completed three years of HS and has at least 17 credits

SEMESTER EXAMS

Underclassman Exams are scheduled for May 24th, May 25th, and May 26th. Semester and final exams for high school level courses are not eligible for reassessment. Students who do not return a parental permission form (attached) completed and signed to the main office by Tuesday, May 17th will be required to be in attendance from 7:35 a.m. to 2:37 p.m. each exam day. Extra permission forms are available in the main office. Buses will run at the normal time. Students who ride a bus home will be required to attend the afternoon study hall. Students may not leave school property and return to ride a school bus. All absences for exam periods must be approved through the high school office. Unexcused absences will result in a failing score on the exam, as there is no reassessment option for exams.

Exam Exemptions

Students may qualify for up to two (2) exam exemptions in January and up to two (2) exams in May.

Exemption Qualification – Quarter grades of A's or B's AND teacher permission

CHROMEBOOK RETURN

We will be collecting all Chromebooks that have not been paid for in full Thursday, May 19th through Thursday, May 26th. The Chromebooks will be stored at school over the summer and returned to students when they return from summer break and the payment plan is up-to-date. Chromebooks not returned will be considered lost and a \$200 fee will be added to your child's school fees. The charger is required to be returned with the Chromebook and will be stored with the device. There will be a \$25 fee for a lost charger. A lost Chromebook or a lost charger does not qualify for the fee waiver. If you intended to purchase the Chromebook, so that it may be kept over the summer, the remaining balance will need to be paid by Thursday, May 26, 2022. HOW IT WORKS
