### RENEWAL LEVY ON NOVEMBER 5<sup>th</sup> BALLOT

Our 5.9 mill operating levy expires at the end of 2020 and is  
on the November 5<sup>th</sup> general election ballot for renewal.  
Passage of this issue will not result in a tax increase.

This levy, first passed in 2000, provides almost \$1.2 million  
dollars in support for the day-to-day operations of the  
District. Instead of renewing for a five-year term as in the  
past, the Board of Education is requesting this levy be  
renewed for a continuing period of time. If supported,  
voters will not need to renew this levy in the future.
