Creating a Legacy of Academic Excellence in Urbana!

Twenty-seven students from Urbana Junior/High School competed in the Ohio History Day state level competition on Saturday April 27th. The competition took place at Ohio Wesleyan University in Delaware Ohio. Students presented historical boards, websites, and performances. This process began in October and different levels of revision and competition have been going on since. Four high school students were chosen to compete at the National History Day Competition in Maryland this summer! In the past 5 years, Urbana has sent 7 national competitors!

On Wednesday April 24th over 400 middle schoolers from Urbana City Schools served their community in a variety of ways. Students cleaned gardens and parks, visited nursing homes, made gift baskets for police and firefighters, and painted at the county fairgrounds. Students returned with a lot of great stories to share and a new appreciation for their community and all it has to offer.

Columbus Zoo

Fourteen Urbana Junior High Students had a wonderful experience at the Columbus Zoo all thanks the a generous grant from the zoo and the desire to carry on research for their project based learning unit! These students created a project for National History Day based on this years theme of "Triumph and Tragedy" where they explored the "tragedy" of older zoo habitats and how they had a negative effect on animals. Then, they researched the "triumph" of the Columbus Zoo and how their vision of habitats that are healthier and more engaging for animals became a reality under the guidance of Jack Hanna. Students created projects boards that displayed their research. They worked directly with zoo employees who assisted them by sending them pictures and historical information about the zoo. The students then visited the zoo to do more research on location. They will then revamp their projects to include more information that they found there and they will also have their projects reviewed by zoo employees. Finally, they will revise and recreate their original projects, share these new projects with Columbus Zoo employees, and display them in the lobby of the K-8 building so all students can see their final projects.
