Field Trip to Ohio Hi-Point Career Center

On February 26th, our 8th graders will have the opportunity to tour Ohio Hi-Point (OHP) and learn more about the programs and unique education the career center offers. Tours will last approximately 90 minutes and be lead by OHP students, giving our 8th graders the opportunity to see 90% of the high-tech labs on OHP's campus. Following the tour, students will have a Q & A session with OHP students and staff. Students will leave UJHS around 9:00 AM and return by 1:30pm. While touring the facility, some of the labs require students to go outside so please make sure your student brings a coat and dresses accordingly. Lunch on February 26th will take place at a fast food restaurant in Bellefontaine. Students need to bring money (\$5.00 - \$10.00) for their lunch.

Washington Information – 8th Grade Trip

Washington DC trip dates: October 21-25, 2019.

Cost: \$600.00*

First payment of \$150.00 due February 28th 2019, Second payment of \$150.00 due March 29th 2019, Third payment of \$150.00 due May 3rd, 2019, Final payment of \$150.00 is due on September 4th, 2019. Cut-off date for a refund is September 6th, 2018. Trip eligibility and other additional information are available in the student handbook and detailed information will be sent home with students during the school year. All school fees must be paid prior to making payments for the Washington Trip. Deadlines must be met for all payments and also for any paperwork associated with this trip. Students who fail to meet these deadlines will be moved to the end of the waiting list. *This is an estimate until trip details are finalized.

If you choose to make payments, 1st payment of \$30.00 due September 21st, 2nd payment of \$30.00 due October 25th, 3rd payment of 30.00 due November 16th, and the final payment of \$35.00 due on February 22nd. If you want to just pay in full, the total amount is due on February 22nd. Refund cut off date is April 12th. **All 6th grade students may attend Kirkmont.** Information is in the student handbook and detailed information will be sent home with students during the school year.
