Ohio's new College Credit Plus (CCP) initiative can help students earn college and high school credits at the same time by taking college courses from community colleges or area universities. The purpose of this program is to promote rigorous academic pursuits and to provide a wide variety of options for the college-ready student. Formerly known as dual-enrollment or PSEO (post-secondary enrollment options), College Credit Plus provides students an opportunity to take courses and earn high school and college credit that appears on both their high school and college transcripts. We invite you to attend this Informational Night to learn more about the guidelines and compliance measures of the College Credit Plus Program.
