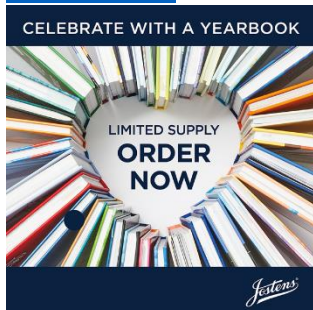

Health Updates

There has been an uptick of positive COVID cases in Whatcom County in general and we are seeing more positive cases in our schools since returning from Spring Break.

Please help keep our community healthy and classrooms open by keeping students home who are symptomatic or ill. Call the school and speak to one of our health staff to review symptoms or to report an exposure to COVID and to schedule testing if needed.

If an exposure to a positive case occurs in school, a health team member will notify students/families of the possible exposure and offer testing. Monitoring for symptoms and testing two times within a week of a known exposure is highly recommended to reduce the risk of spread of COVID but not required. Rapid COVID testing at every school site is readily available.

Should an outbreak occur in a classroom or within a specific group (sports or clubs), the health department may require short term use of masks, testing and/or moving to remote learning.

Actualización de salud

Ha habido un aumento de casos positivos de COVID en el condado de Whatcom y estamos viendo más casos positivos en nuestras escuelas desde que regresamos de las vacaciones de primavera.

Ayude a mantener nuestra comunidad saludable y las aulas abiertas manteniendo a los estudiantes en casa que tienen síntomas o están enfermos. Llame a la escuela y hable con alguien de nuestro personal de salud para revisar los síntomas o informar una exposición a COVID y programar pruebas si es necesario.

Si ocurre una exposición a un caso positivo en la escuela, un miembro del equipo de salud notificará a los estudiantes/familias de la posible exposición y ofrecerá la prueba. Se recomienda enfáticamente realizar la prueba dos veces dentro de una semana de una exposición conocida para reducir la propagación de COVID, pero no es obligatorio. Las pruebas rápidas de COVID están en cada sitio están disponibles escolar.

En caso de que ocurra un brote en un salón de clases o dentro de un grupo específico (deportes o clubes), el departamento de salud puede requerir el uso a corto plazo de máscaras, pruebas y/o pasar al aprendizaje remoto.
