



With 784 students. the co-educational student body reflects the rich ethnic and cultural diversity of the Bay Area, and the school has enjoyed a 100% collegiate matriculation. Our graduating seniors have been accepted into 1,000+ universities and colleges yearly, and have garnered, on average, between \$11-14 million in scholarships and grants.


